Our son, husband, daddy, "Gramps", brother and best friend temporarily said goodbye on July 7, 2009, in Springdale. Harold David Fulfer was born on March 22, 1951, in Prairie Grove to James Preston (Jay) and Catherine LaWanda Fulfer.

As a native of Springdale, he graduated in 1969 from Springdale High School and in 1974 received his degree from the University of Arkansas in Banking and Finance. He attended First Assembly of God in Springdale for 57 years, teaching Sunday school & serving as deacon for 32 years. He was a realtor and owner of Wilkins Homes, Inc and Westfield Chapel funeral home in Springdale.
