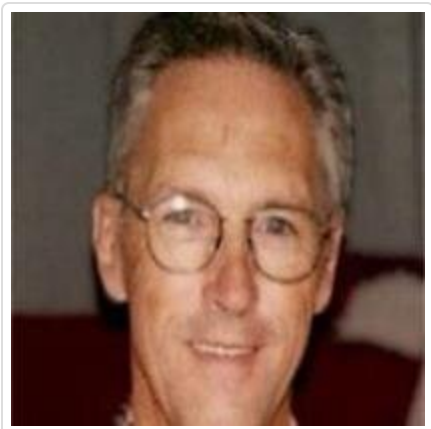




## Larry D. Cook

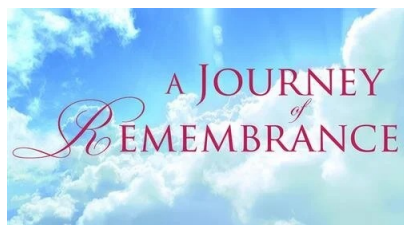

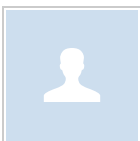
