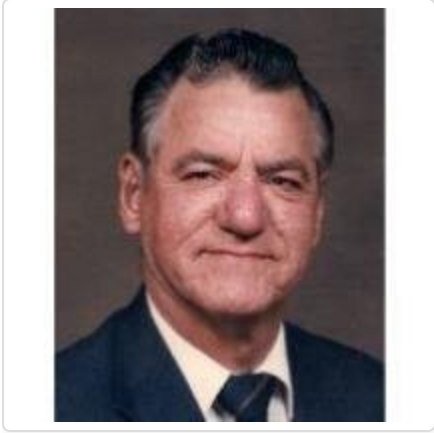




Ray Harbour

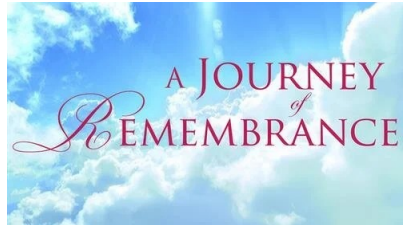
